5. Which sentence is the longest (single crime or enhancement)?

6. What crime was that sentence for (controlling offense)?

7. How old were you when the controlling offense was committed?

8. Were you sentenced for THIS offense under the “Three Strikes Law” (Penal Code sections 1170.12; 667 or 667.61)? _____ (Yes / No)
9. Did you commit any crimes after turning 18 (most likely while in prison) for which a court sentenced you to a prison term? _____ (Yes/ No)
10. Did any of the crimes committed by you AFTER AGE 18 have as a necessary element of the crime “malice aforethought?” If you don’t know, just state the crime and penal code section. _____
11. Were you sentenced to any term of Life for the crime committed after age 18 yrs old? _____
